**GENERAL METERED SERVICE (T)**

**SPECIAL CONDITIONS**

1. The annual service charge and surcharge applies to service during the 12-month period commencing January 1 and is due in advance. When a customer has been a customer of the utility for at least 12 months, the customer may elect, at the beginning of the calendar year, to pay prorated service charges in advance at intervals of less than one year (monthly, bimonthly, or quarterly) in accordance with the utility's established billing periods. (L)

The meter will be read and quantity charges billed monthly, bimonthly or quarterly in accordance with the utility's established billing periods except that meters may be read and quantity charges billed during the winter season at intervals greater than three months. (L)

2. The opening bill for metered service, except upon conversion from flat rate service, shall be the established annual service charge for the service. Where Initial service is established after the first day of any year, the portion of such annual charge applicable to the current year shall be determined by multiplying the annual charge by one three hundred-sixty-fifth (1/365) of the number of dates remaining in the calendar year. The balance of the payment of the initial annual charge shall be credited against the charges for the succeeding annual period. If the service is not continued for at least one year after the date of initial service, no refund of the Initial annual charge shall be due the customer.

3. All bills are subject to the reimbursement fee set forth In Schedule No. UF. (D)

4. A monthly bill surcharge shall be applied to each customer's monthly water bill to amortize the undercollection of revenue from June 17, 2014 to March 26, 2015. The amount of the surcharge is as follows:

For 1 inch meter	\$ .53
For 1 ½ inch meter	\$ 6.79
For 2 inch meter	\$ 13.78
For 4 inch meter	\$ 51.60

5. In the event that a customer terminates service under this schedule and reinstates service at the same location, there will be a reconnection charge (see Rule No. 11, C. Restoration of Service, 1. Reconnection Charge). Any customer, prior to resuming service within twelve months after such service was discontinued, will be required to pay all service charges and surcharges that would have been billed if service had not been discontinued.
6. A \$3.18 bill surcharge shall be applied to each customer's monthly water bill to amortize the Purchased Water Balancing Account of \$56,294.78. The surcharge shall be separately identified on each bill. (C)

**ANNUAL FLAT RATE SERVICE**

**APPLICABILITY**

Applicable to all residential water service furnished on a flat rate basis.

**TERRITORY**

This Schedule is applicable with the entire territory served by the utility

**RATES**

	<u>Water Per Year</u>
For a single family residential unit, including premises	\$685.16
For each additional single-family residential unit on the same premises and served from the same service connection	\$411.09
Hotels, apartments, and motels: For first room or unit	\$685.16
For each additional room or unit on the same Premises and served from the same service Connection	\$342.59
For each market, store or office	\$685.16

**SPECIAL CONDITIONS**

1. The above residential flat rate charges apply to service connections not larger than one inch in diameter. (L)
2. For service covered by the above classifications, if the utility so elects, a meter shall be installed, and service provided under Schedule 1A, Monthly Metered Service, effective as of the first day of the following calendar month. Where the flat rate charge for a period has been paid in advance, refund of the prorated difference between such flat rate payment and the meter service charge for the same period shall be made on or before that date (L)

- 3. The annual flat rate charge applies to service during the 12-month period commencing January 1 and is due in advance. If a permanent resident of the area has been a customer of the utility for at least 12 months, the customer may elect, at the beginning of the calendar year, to pay prorated flat rate charges and surcharges in advance at intervals of less than one year (monthly, bimonthly or quarterly) in accordance with the utility's established billing periods. A nonpermanent resident may elect to pay the annual charge in two equal installments. Where such a resident has failed to pay the first half of the annual charge due January 1, service will not be restored until the total annual charge has been paid.
- 4. The opening bill for flat rate service shall be the established annual flat rate charge for the service. Where initial service is established after the first day of any year, the portion of such annual charge applicable to the current year shall be determined by multiplying the annual charge by one three-hundred-sixty-fifth (1/365) of the number of days remaining in the calendar year. The balance of the payment of the initial annual charge shall be credited against the charges for the succeeding annual period. If the service is not continued for at least one year after the date of initial service, no refund of the initial annual charge shall be due the customer.
- 5. All bills are subject to the reimbursement fee set forth in Schedule No. UF.
- 6. A percentage surcharge of 9.02% will be applied to the Flat Rates above for a period of 36 months from the effective date of Advice Letter 59 until \$189,300 of undercollected revenue per Res. W-5026 is collected.
- 7. In the event that a customer terminates service under this schedule and reinstates service at the same location, there will be a reconnection charge (see Rule No. 11, C. Restoration of Service, 1. Reconnection Charge). Any customer, prior to resuming service within twelve months after such service was discontinued, will be required to pay all service charges and surcharges that would have been billed if service had not been discontinued.
