Applicable to all water service furnished on a flat rate basis.

TERRITORY

This Schedule is applicable with the entire territory served by the utility.

RATES

For each market, store or office	\$1,160.20	(I)

SPECIAL CONDITIONS

1. The above residential flat rate charges apply to service connections not larger than one inch in diameter.
2. For service covered by the above classifications, if the utility so elects, a meter shall be installed, and service provided under Schedule 1A, Monthly Metered Service, effective as of the first day of the following calendar month. Where the flat rate charge for a period has been paid in advance, refund of the prorated difference between such flat rate payment and the meter service charge for the same period shall be made on or before that date.

SPECIAL CONDITIONS (continued)

8. In the event that a customer terminates service under this schedule and reinstates service at the same location, there will be a reconnection charge (See Rule No. 11, C. Restoration of Service 1. Reconnection Charge). Any customer, prior to resuming service within twelve months after such service was discontinued, will be required to pay all service charges and surcharges that would have been billed if service has not been discontinued. (C)
9. As authorized by CPUC Resolution W-5209, a monthly surcharge of \$10.55 shall be applied to each customer's bill to collect the under collected revenues from February 19, 2019, the interim date, to the effective date of the new rates established by Res. W-5209. The monthly surcharge shall be applied for 60 months or until \$621,507 is recovered. (L)
10. As authorized by the Commission, pursuant to Commission Resolution W-5242 and Decision 10-10-018, all bills are subject to a \$2.91 surcharge to recover \$102,604 recorded in the Water Contamination Litigation Expense Balancing Account (WCLEBA), amortized over a period of 36 months from the effective date of Advice Letter 82A-W. The amortization is subject to refund from any proceeds resulting from the water contamination in accordance with Commission Decision 10-10-018. The surcharge shall be separately identified on each bill. (L)

PRIVATE FIRE PROTECTION SERVICE

APPLICABILITY

Applicable to all water service furnished for fire protection systems and to private fire hydrants.

TERRITORY

This Schedule is applicable with the entire territory served by the utility.

RATES

	<u>Per Year</u>	
For each inch of diameter of service connection	\$267.52	(I)

SPECIAL CONDITIONS

1. The fire protection service connection will be installed by the utility and the cost paid by the applicant. Such payment shall not be subject to refund.
2. The maximum diameter for the fire protection services shall not be more than the diameter of the main to which service is connected.
3. If the distribution main of adequate size to serve a private fire protection system in addition to all other normal service does not exist in the street or alley adjacent to the premises to be served, the a service main from the nearest existing main of adequate capacity shall be installed by the utility and the cost paid by the applicant. Such payment shall not be subject to refund.
4. Service hereunder is for private fire protection systems to which no connections for other than fire protection purposes are allowed. The fire protection service connection shall be installed by the utility, according to specifications of the San Bernardino County Fire Department and the cost paid by the applicant. Such payment shall not be subject to refund. The utility may install a meter or the standard protection against theft, leakage, or waste of water. The cost of the facilities will be paid by the applicant and not subject to refund.
5. The utility undertakes to supply only such water at such pressure as may be available at any time through the normal operation of the system.
6. A \$3.08 bill surcharge shall be applied to each customer's monthly water bill to amortize the Purchased Water Balancing Account of \$54,413.82. The surcharge shall be separately identified on each bill and in place for a period of 18 months, or until the full amount has been collected, from the effective date of Advice Letter 86-W.

SPECIAL CONDITIONS_(continued)

- 7. In the event that a customer terminates service under this schedule and reinstates service at the same location, there will be a reconnection charge (see Rule No. 11, C. Restoration of Service, 1. Reconnection Charge). Any customer, prior to resuming service within twelve months after such service was discontinued, will be required to pay all service charges and surcharges that would have been billed if service had not been discontinued. (C)
- 8. As authorized by the Commission, pursuant to PU Code Section 792.5 and Commission Decision 10-10-018, all bills are subject to a surcharge to recover the Water Contamination Litigation Expense Balancing Account (WCLEBA) for the years 2017-2019, in the amount of \$102,604.07 amortized over three years. A surcharge in the amount of \$2.91 shall be applied to each customer's monthly water bill beginning with the effective date of Advice Letter 82-W and continue until the 12/31/2019 balancing account balance, with interest, is recovered. The surcharge shall be separately identified on each bill. (C)
- 9. As authorized by CPUC Resolution W-5209, a monthly surcharge of \$10.55 shall be applied to each customer's bill to collect the under collected revenues from February 19, 2019, the interim rate date, to the effective date of the new rates established by Res. W-5209. The monthly surcharge shall be applied for 60 months or until \$621,507 is recovered. (C)

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
