- 6. A \$3.08 bill surcharge shall be applied to each customer's monthly water bill to amortize the Purchased Water Balancing Account of \$54,413.82. The surcharge shall be separately identified on each bill and in place for a period of 18 months, or until the full amount has been collected, from the effective date of Advice Letter 86-W.
