GENERAL METERED SERVICE

APPLICABILITY

Applicable to all water service furnished on a metered basis.

TERRITORY

This Schedule is applicable with the entire territory served by the utility.

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Schedule No. 2A

ANNUAL FLAT RATE SERVICE

APPLICABILITY

Applicable to all water service furnished on a flat rate basis.

TERRITORY

This Schedule is applicable with the entire territory served by the utility.

RATES

Hotels, apartments, and motels: For first room or unit	\$1,572.85	(I)

For each market, store or office	\$1,572.85	(I)

SPECIAL CONDITIONS

1. The above residential flat rate charges apply to service connections not larger than one inch in diameter.
2. For service covered by the above classifications, if the utility so elects, a meter shall be installed, and service provided under Schedule 1A, Monthly Metered Service, effective as of the first day of the following calendar month. Where the flat rate charge for a period has been paid in advance, refund of the prorated difference between such flat rate payment and the meter service charge for the same period shall be made on or before that date.

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Schedule No. 4

PRIVATE FIRE PROTECTION SERVICE

APPLICABILITY

Applicable to all water service furnished fire protection systems and to private fire hydrants.

TERRITORY

This Schedule is applicable with the entire territory served by the utility.

RATES

	<u>Per Year</u>	
For each inch of diameter of service connection	\$362.67	(I)

SPECIAL CONDITIONS

1. The fire protection service connection will be installed by the utility and the cost paid by the applicant. Such payment shall not be subject to refund.
2. The maximum diameter for the fire protection services shall not be more than the diameter of the main to which service is connected.
3. If the distribution main of adequate size to serve a private fire protection system in addition to all other normal service does not exist in the street or alley adjacent to the premises to be served, a service main from the nearest existing main of adequate capacity shall be installed by the utility and the cost paid by the applicant. Such payment shall not be subject to refund.
4. Service hereunder is for private fire protection systems to which no connections for other than fire protection purposes are allowed. The fire protection service connection shall be installed by the utility, according to specifications of the San Bernardino County Fire Department and the cost paid by the applicant. Such payment shall not be subject to refund. The utility may install a meter or the standard protection against theft, leakage, or waste of water. The cost of the facilities will be paid by the applicant and not subject to refund.
5. The utility undertakes to supply only such water at such pressure as may be available at any time through the normal operation of the system.
6. A \$3.08 bill surcharge shall be applied to each customer's monthly water bill to amortize the Purchased Water Balancing Account of \$54,413.82. The surcharge shall be separately identified on each bill and in place for a period of 18 months, or until the full amount has been collected, from the effective date of Advice Letter 86-W.

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Schedule No. F

FACILITIES FEES

APPLICABILITY

Applicable to all customers applying for service from the Utility in the territory served for premises not previously connected to its distribution mains for additional service connections to existing premises, and for increases in size of service connections to existing premises.

TERRITORY

This Schedule is applicable with the entire territory served by the utility.

3. These fees shall be used only for the repair and replacement or the installation of new infrastructure.
4. These fees shall be deposited in a separate trustee account and used only upon permission of the Water Division or its successors.

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
